



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Reading Features

Studies Weekly Online contains useful reading features.

- The Audio Reader narrates every article and assessment question as needed
- The Highlight and Annotation Tool records student work and notations
- The Reader Mode expands the article to full-screen view


Try each feature.

After listening to the article, look for the article level question(s) below the text.

Each question is color-coded. Find the answer to the question in the article and highlight the answer in that color.

Assessments

Studies Weekly Online features two types of assessments within each publication.


- Article assessments are found at the bottom of each article. They are color coded and may be used with the highlight tool.
- Weekly assessments are under the Table of Contents and provide the ability to ask 9 different types of questions.

Both types of assessments are customizable and can be assigned to your students.

Grading Assignments

You can view and grade student submissions 3 different ways:

- 1. In the Grade tab
- 2. In the **Grade** area of the Article or Assessment
- 3. Using the Customized Content tab

Only some questions need to be graded by teachers. Live grading is available when students submit Article Questions, Explore More Questions, and Crosswords.

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Reports & Data


Student data is provided in a variety of ways so you can see individual or class progress, and weekly assessment scores.

Accessibility Features

Students and Teachers have access to accessibility tools inside Studies Weekly Online.

- Teachers have access to the accessibility features automatically and can adjust their own account's accessibility features by clicking the Accessibility button on the sidebar.
- Teachers will need to enable the feature for the tool to appear on Student accounts.

To enable accessibility tools for a student...


Click Classes

To access each game...


Click the arrow next to your username and select Study Buddies or Explorers
